What is P.B.I.S.?

PBIS is a researched-based, school-wide behavior and support system that is developed by a school in order to target and improve student behavior. Research is clear that an increase in expected behavior is directly correlated to higher student achievement. P.B.I.S. is:

- Used with all students
- Used across all school environments
- Used to help schools create effective learning environments
- Data - driven

What is the Purpose?

- Improve the climate of Oakfield Middle School so that all students will demonstrate respectful behavior
- “Speak” a common language so that all Oakfield Middle School staff and students know the three school-wide expectations of Respect, Responsibility, and Safety
- Consistently teach three school-wide expectations of Respect, Responsibility, and Safety so that all staff and students know what each looks like in all Oakfield Middle School campus settings
- Positively reinforce staff and students for following the three school-wide expectations of Respect, Responsibility, and Safety
- Be data-driven in our approach to policy-making
