Through this activity, the society supports and recommends the use of a multifaceted definition of character known as the "Six Pillars of Character." A person of character demonstrates the following six qualities: respect, responsibility, trustworthiness, fairness, caring, and citizenship.

In addition, it can also be said that the student of character:

- *Takes criticism willingly and accepts recommendations graciously
- *Consistently exemplifies desirable qualities of behavior (poise, cheerfulness, friendliness, stability)
- *Upholds principles of morality and ethics
- *Cooperates by complying with school regulations concerning property, programs, office, halls, etc.
- *Demonstrates the highest standards of honesty and reliability
- *Regularly shows courtesy, concern, and respect for others
- *Observes instructions and rules, is punctual, and faithful both inside and outside the classroom.
- *Has powers of concentration, self-discipline, and sustained attention as shown by perseverance and application to studies
- *Manifests truthfulness in acknowledging obedience to rules, avoiding cheating in written work, and showing unwillingness to profit by the mistakes of others
- *Actively helps rid the school of bad influences or environment
