The Fond du Lac Area Insurance Association Scholarship is available to senior students graduating from Fond du Lac High School, St. Mary Springs Academy, Winnebago Lutheran Academy, North Fond du Lac High School, Campbellsport High School, Laconia High School, Ripon High School, and Oakfield High School, as well as home-schooled students, pursuing a college or technical degree. - E. Essay on the **Benefits of Insurance** (1 page)
