• Playground Update

- o The PTO has paid off our portion of the playground costs, and we will NOT have to do any additional fundraising for the playground! Amazing!! Thank you to everyone who has helped the project come to fruition!
 - The retail price of all equipment, removal, installation, wood chips, etc totalled about \$201,000.
 - The PTO & the School District together paid just under \$88,000 for everything.
 - Huge thank you to BCI Burke, Scott Liebelt, Becky Doyle, Jonny Wessel, the Oakfield School District, and the Playground committee for all of the hard work to make this happen!

• Principal's Report

- The students are back to school after Christmas break! Welcome back!
- Thank you to all families for helping keep our Elementary School open. We are one of the only schools in the area that has been able to stay open for the entire school year. Thank you to families and teachers for being flexible as students and classes have had to quarantine. Thank you to staff for continuing to work hard with sanitizing and helping maintain proper protocols and procedures to keep everyone safe.
- Please continue to make sure that students are prepared for school each day with water bottles, clean masks, extra masks, & winter gear.
- The next School Board Meeting is Monday, January 11.
- Dr. Dalzin is retiring at the end of the school year. Cesa 6 is helping with the search for a new superintendent. We will keep you updated as the search progresses.
- Winter benchmark assessments are coming up in the next couple of weeks.
- Kids Heart Challenge (formally Jump Rope for Heart) will take place in students' Phy Ed. classes, rather than as an after school activity this year. Mrs. Albert will send home more information as the event gets closer.
- Spring Parent teacher conferences will be coming up in February They will be virtual.
- Summer School is in the beginning planning phase. We are planning for summer school to be in person. Some schedule changes are being proposed including shortening the hours from 8:00-12:00 (rather than 12:30), shortening summer school from 6 weeks (Two 3 week sessions) to 4 or 5 weeks (only one session), and having Fridays off. Finding enough staffing is a big concern this year, especially with COVID. If you have any feedback regarding summer school, please contact Mrs. Doyle.

• Oakfield Elementary will be welcoming some new faces in a few weeks. We will have 2 interns working in Special Education and 2nd grade. There will also be a Student Teacher in 1st Grade.
