- **Request for books - One School, One Book**
 - Jen Harrison presented on behalf of The OES Literacy Committee. The committee would like to bring the One School, One Book program to Oakfield Elementary School. One School, One Book is a program designed to create a shared reading experience across an entire school community. We will choose a children's novel and provide every family with a copy. Following a common schedule across the school, every family reads that book together at home and students and staff will participate in activities at school as well. The cost for the books and program guides will be somewhere between \$1200-\$1500.
 - Holly Flatau made a motion to approve funding for up to \$1500. Koreen Larson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
